The City is requesting sealed bids for **AMERICAN WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) TRANSITION PLAN** for the City of North Lauderdale. SCOPE OF WORK: The City seeks a qualified Consultant experienced in the evaluation and development of an Accessibility Transition Plan for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (“ADA”).

The awarded Consultant will provide a self-evaluation of City of North Lauderdale public buildings; parks and recreational facilities; programs; and right-of-way facilities. This evaluation will result in a Transition Plan of deficiencies and necessary improvements to meet ADA requirements. The Plan should comply with 28 C.F.R. 35.105 and 150, include a schedule listing priority and timeline of completion, with an estimate of associated costs. The Plan should meet the current industry ADA accessible format.

The selected Consultant will be required to describe the proposed plan, provide recommendations and a schedule based on priority. The project to complete improvements will be divided into two (2) phases. Therefore, the selected Consultant will be required to provide phased evaluation plans and cost estimates for the evaluation of the entire project based on the prepared plan.

A **mandatory pre-bid city tour** will be held on **Wednesday, March 20, 2019 @ 10:00am EST** starting at City Hall located at **701 SW 71st Avenue, North Lauderdale, FL 33068**. Please refer to the Bid Documents for details on how to attend.

The City of North Lauderdale reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities or irregularities in any bid received, to re-advertise for bids, or to take any other such actions that may be deemed to be in the best interest of the City. The City anticipates entering into a written contract with the bidder who submits the bid judged by the City to be the most advantageous, responsible, and most responsive.
