



**INVITATION TO BID
SILVER LAKES DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS

ALL PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS:

The City is requesting sealed bids for **SILVER LAKES DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS** for the City of North Lauderdale. Sealed proposals, including one (1) original, three (3) copies, and one (1) single pdf file on a flash drive, addressed to the Purchasing Division of the City of North Lauderdale, Broward County, Florida, will be accepted by the Office of the City Clerk, 701 SW 71st Avenue, North Lauderdale, Florida 33068 until 10:00 am EST, **Thursday, June 13, 2019**.

SCOPE OF WORK: The City of North Lauderdale wishes to contract with a licensed and insured Contractor for the provision of labor and materials to complete the Silver Lakes Drainage Improvements project. The proposed stormwater conveyance system for this project consists of retrofitting portions of S.W. 10th Street, S.W. 10th Court and S.W. 76th Avenue with a new drainage system. This project will remove the existing undersized drainage structures and associated 20' runs of 12" exfiltration trench and replace them with a series of larger inlet structures and runs of solid pipe. The new drainage system will connect to the existing drainage system at a structure on Tam O'shanter Blvd. just west of S.W. 76th Avenue.

This is a federally funded project under Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). All HUD Federal Rules and regulations pertaining to this project are applicable.

Federal Davis-Bacon Wage Rates for work classifications are specified and must be complied with. Fringe benefits must be added to the prevailing hourly rates where applicable.

Bidders must comply with Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968 which requires that economic opportunities to the greatest extent feasible be given to low and very low income persons and to businesses that provide economic opportunities for these persons. The City encourages local contractors and sign companies who reside and/or do business within the City to participate in the bidding process.

Bid documents may be obtained from the City of North Lauderdale website at www.nlauderdale.org or DemandStar at www.demandstar.com which will be available on **Monday, May 13, 2019** at 12:00 pm. Public notice is hereby given that a "Cone of Silence" is imposed concerning this competitive purchasing process. This generally prohibits communications concerning the ITB from the time of advertisement of the ITB until such time as the City Commission approves the award. All communication regarding this bid shall be directed to Susan Nabors, Finance Director, via email at snabors@nlauderdale.org. There is no charge for the documents. The bid documents contain the specifications for the Silver Lakes Drainage Improvements.

A **mandatory pre-bid meeting** will be held on **Thursday, May 23, 2019 @ 10:00am** EST. Interested Consultants are to meet at City Hall located at **701 SW 71st Avenue, North Lauderdale, FL 33068**.

The City of North Lauderdale reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities or irregularities in any bid received, to re-advertise for bids, or to take any other such actions that may be deemed to be in the best interest of the City. The City anticipates entering into a written contract with the bidder who submits the bid judged by the City to be the most advantageous, responsible, and most responsive.

Late bids will not be considered. The City of North Lauderdale is not liable for any costs incurred by a bidder in responding to this Invitation to Bid.
