

**NOTICE INVITING BIDS
RCMP 2017-2018**

All bids are due on Monday, November 27, 2017 by 10:00 am in the City Clerk's office at 701 SW 71st Avenue, 2nd floor in a sealed standard size white envelope (4x9). Clearly mark on the outside of the envelope your company's name, HLMP, the job number, and the property address. Bid openings will take place on the first floor conference room of City Hall immediately after.

This project includes the mitigation of 13 owner occupied homes contingent upon grant funding availability. The bid announcement and General Specifications and Scope of Work were e-mailed to contractors November 6, 2017. This project is state funded through the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management, Hurricane Loss Mitigation Program (HLMP), formerly called the Residential Construction Mitigation Program (RCMP). All federal and state rules and regulations pertaining to this project are applicable.

The City of North Lauderdale reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities or irregularities in any bid received, to re-advertise for bids, or to take any other such actions that may be deemed to be in the best interest of the Owner and the City. The City anticipates letting the Owner enter into a written contract with the bidder who submits the bid judged by the City to be the most advantageous, responsible, and most responsive. The City is not required to award any jobs to a Contractor based solely on their bid being the lowest. Awards will be based on past performance and quality of work in addition to bid. The most jobs any one contractor can be awarded at one time will be three. New contractors who have not worked for the City prior will be awarded only one job.

If selected for a project, all bidders must earn a satisfactory performance evaluation rating prior to being considered for award of additional contracts. Bidders whose performance is unsatisfactory will be excluded from bidding on future projects for one or more fiscal years. The decision to exclude a bidder and the number of years a bidder is excluded is in the sole and exclusive discretion of the City and is not subject to appeal.
